

# Instructions for submitting authors

## Abstract formatting

**Title: 12pt, Bold, Times New Roman Font, 12pt spacing below paragraph.**

*Author(s): 11pt, Times New Roman Font, italic, 0pt spacing above and below paragraphs.*

Underline presenting author.

Affiliation(s) and E-mail(s): 10pt, Times New Roman Font, mark with <sup>1,2,3</sup>..., 0pt spacing above and below paragraphs.

Body part: 11pt with single space, Times New Roman Font, 12pt spacing below paragraphs.

Key words: 11pt, Times New Roman Font, 12pt spacing below paragraph.

Page layout: all frames 2.5cm, single line spacing.

- Abstracts will be limited to **300 words**
- The following formats are accepted: Microsoft Word (.doc, .docx), Open Office (.odt), Rich Text Format (.rtf), Plain Text (.txt)
- Include the names and affiliations for all co-authors
- Abstracts must be submitted and presented in standard English (BE / AE) language
- Maximum file size: 2MB

4. Name the PDF file and save it on your computer
